## Joint Annual Legal Update with IOSH - Thursday 13th January 2022 at 10.00am Covid Secure Procedures for Attendees:

To attend this event you should be:

- Fully Vaccinated with an approved Covid-19 Vaccine
- or have completed a negative PCR test or negative Lateral Flow Test within the previous 48 hours
- or be exempt
- AND not suffering any of the symptoms associated with Covid-19.
- Not required to self-isolate.

Covid Status checks are not compulsory for this event, but we will be carrying out random checks on a voluntary basis.

- You should be able to demonstrate your Covid Status, if asked.

Accepted means of proof is a physical copy of the NHS Covid Pass or a NHS Covid Pass QR code on your smart phone, available via the NHS App.

You are invited to check in at the Covid Tracking QR code specific to this event – multiple copies of the same code will be distributed around the Ballroom.

You can also check in at the BAWA venue QR code if you wish.

- Please have the Covid Tracking app live during the event with your phone on silent or muted.

Through ventilation will be used throughout the event.

Full extract ventilation will be operating during the event,

- be prepared, you may need to wear a jumper.

- **Wear a Face Mask** unless seated.

Please put on your face covering before entering the building, and wear it until you are sat down (or eating or drinking), and when you leave.

Speakers are exempt from wearing a face covering while presenting.

An 'emergency supply' of face coverings will be available, but it's better if you bring your own.

- Please do not stop to sign in at the lobby door as usual > clip boards will be circulated instead.
- If you see a bottle neck / queue of people, please hang back and let it clear first.
- Seats will be socially distanced (so there will be fewer than you are used too). Please do not crowd any of the booths. Groups can sit together if they wish.
- Please use the Hand Sanitiser available at various locations around the building, or you can bring your own.
